# **Application procedure**

Before you come to study to University of Pardubice you must prepare yourself for a certain administration process. It's not that difficult. To make it as easy and smooth as possible we will take you through the individual steps of our procedure.

We kindly ask you to prepare and send us the following documents:

# 1. online APPLICATION FORM (AF)

Fill the online application form that will be available since March in the file <u>*Erasmus Application form.*</u> You don't need to print out the AF.

## 2. LEARNING AGREEMENT (LA)

Download the form from the file <u>Application forms</u>. Only original forms of University of Pardubice will be accepted. Please fill the Learning agreement and let it approve by your home departmental as well as institutional coordinator.

You can find the lists of courses of different faculties in the next file <u>List of courses for Erasmus+</u> <u>students</u>.

You can also choose few subjects from another faculty (1-2), the specific number depends on the host faculty. Please check with the coordinator of your host faculty how many courses from other faculties they accept. The list of our faculty coordinators you can see below.

### 5. PROOF OF YOUR ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETENCE

It means a certificate issued by the University language department of your home institution (we require at least **B1 English Proficiency Level**)

We prefer you to fill mentioned documents on the computer (not by hand) in order to make it readable. All forms must be filled in English, otherwise we cannot accept them.

Our International Mobility Center will confirm your LA and send it back with a **Letter of Acceptance**, an **Accommodation Voucher** as well as all necessary documents in case you apply for visa (Confirmation of accommodation, Confirmation of study - both in Czech language).

### VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

International students coming from EU countries do not need visa. Other international students can get information about visa application procedure at the Czech embassies or consulates in their home countries or they can consult the website of <u>the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic</u>. To be able to get the visa confirmed after your arrival at Immigration department, you must be insured for the whole period of your stay. We recommend you to administrate the health insurance in your country before departure.

If you need VISA, ask at the Czech Embassy/Consulate in your home country about procedure; remember than you need the forms from us and Visa applications should be submitted to the Embassy at least 60 days before the planned date of departure. Department of Physical Education and Sport and the University Sports Club

Physical education facility of the University of Pardubice, which includes **two sports halls, outdoor playground, gym, cardio and Mirror Hall**, is located in the university campus. Part of the premises is a **boatyard** on the Labe river bank with **tennis courts** and other sport **facilities for the rowing** club and other sports.

Department of Physical Education and Sports offers many sports activities throughout the academic community and organizes sports competitions. The department provides Physical education in compulsory and elective courses, where under the optional course students can enroll **ball games**, **aerobics**, **fitness exercises**, **power yoga**, **swimming**, **badminton**, **aqua aerobics**, **squash**, **tennis**, **artificial wall climbing**, **rowing**, **indoor cycling**, **self-defense**, **archery**, **beach volleyball**.

There are also alternative physical activities which are primary offered to students with disabilities. During these activities students have an opportunity to try unconventional sports and psychomotor games.

Furthermore, employees of the Department organize many events, sports competitions between faculties, marathons in aerobics, tournaments in volleyball, basketball, badminton, tennis, floorball, football, weekends with aerobics, rowing races and also provides winter and summer courses.

For performance athletes there is the University sports club, which offers eight different sports: aerobics, badminton, basketball, canoeing, tennis, volleyball, rowing, indoor cycling, table tennis, futsal and floorball.
